RABBI'S MESSAGE SHAVUOT 5771

One of the observances on the Yom Tov of Shavuot was the bringing of Bikkurim - the First Fruits. The Torah tells us that during this Festival of the Harvest, the farmer would bring the choicest fruit to Jerusalem and present them to the Kohein. The Torah continues to tell us that along with this gift came a proclamation in which the giver recites a brief history of our people leading up to that very moment. (Interestingly enough, these few verses found in Devarim, chapter 26, comprise the bulk of the Derashot in the Pesach Hagaddah).



The ceremony of Bikkurim was very moving and joyous, for it provided an opportunity for the average Jew to offer a true outpouring of gratitude and thanks to Hashem for all His goodness and beneficence. In Hebrew we call this term "Hakarat Hatov", which literally means recognizing good. This term is a most important and widespread value in our tradition. We wake up every morning and the first thing we say is "Modeh Ani". "Thank you Hashem for returning me to life"! We teach our children from as young an age as possible to always know how to properly say "Thank You" for even the smallest of things. As parents, we are embarrassed when our children do not thank others properly. Even worse, we are turned off when we see younger (or even older) generations who completely lack an awareness of the value of gratitude.

The Torah requires us in no uncertain terms to thank those who help us even if the help comes from an unlikely source. We are required to thank our parents, our siblings, our friends, and even (especially) our spouses. If the help was not asked for, give thanks. If the help was not what we thought it might be, give thanks. If the help was unnecessary, give thanks. We are "Yehudim", named for Yehuda whose very essence is rooted in the word that means giving thanks.

As we celebrate Shavuot and the beginning of another great summer here at the beach, we must also remember to give proper thanks. We must appreciate that we have a beautiful and vibrant growing shul and community that aims to serve all of our spiritual needs. We must thank Hashem that we live in such a beautiful and pristine location. We must never take for granted such things as our health, family, or general well being. This is one of the messages of Shavuot. We thank Hashem for giving us the Torah to live by and the ability to live by it. Most of all, we thank you all for providing the JCAB with the ability to have another stellar year.

Sarah, the girls and I wish you all a Chag Sameach and a great summer.

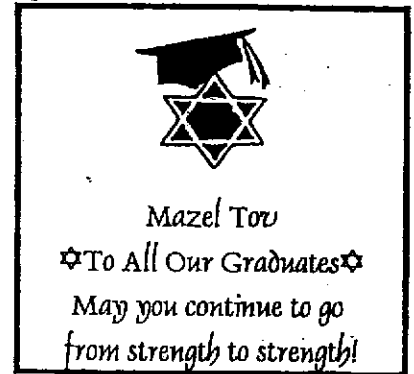

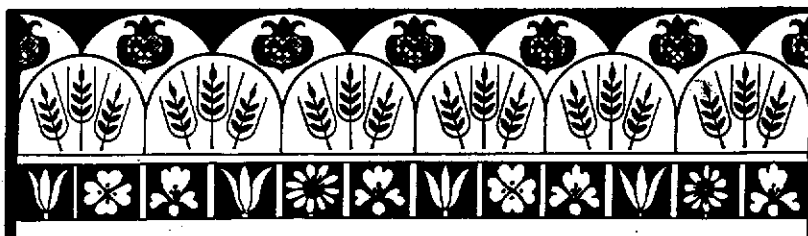
Bat Mitzvah Profile
